A Historical Event happened on Sunday, October 13th, 2024, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Wright, MN. The congregation's members voted to sell the church property to the City of Wright and proceed with Holy Closure as of January 26, 2025. Services will continue at 8 AM until closure is completed. The building will be preserved as a community historical site as the sanctuary will not change. The only changes that will be made are that the city will move into the office space and the fellowship hall will be opened to the community for various events and activities. All these activities will be cleared with the city calendar. Bethlehem is still planning to have a Christmas Eve Service and a big celebration of the life for the church for the past 100 plus years.

Cromwell Mayor Sharon's report: The Small Cities Development program through DEED (Federal) awarded the City a \$660,000 grant for renovation of the pavilion interior. The city's portion will be \$60,000. Spending must occur within 2.5 years. An engineer/architect has been hired and the Pavilion will probably close during winter of 2025-26 to complete the renovation. Next spring will begin the trail from Villa Court to the stop sign on Highway 73. Trees will be removed by 3/31/25; work done by fall. North alley and Muni parking lot paving is being done and should be complete soon.

I see that the painting of the trolley on the old Trolley Inn site has been repainted. Unfortunately, the word "Trolley" is spelled wrong on the painting! OOPS?
